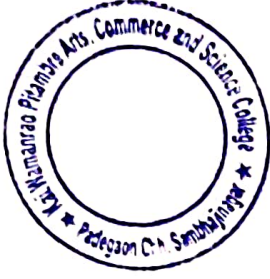
7. Conclusion
